

Education Group Activities

The Education Group consisted of three people: Associate Professor Carroll Bronson of Cardinal Stritch University, Associate Professor Ann Van Eerden of Alverno College, and Ms. Kimiko Miyazaki of WCI.

On the first day, the group visited the Chiba Prefectural Nursing Association, and in addition to getting a complete understanding of nursing in Chiba, observed training and visited the Chiba Prefecture Nursing Center for employment support. Following lunch, the group visited the Wisconsin Friendship Square at the Messe Mall in Makuhari New City and Mihama Park. After that, they visited the Chiba Prefectural Psychiatric Medical Care Center.

On the morning of the second day, the group paid a courtesy call with the Governor, and in the afternoon traveled to Makuhari to visit the Chiba Prefectural General Education Center. The center has been systematically training faculty and staff in Chiba Prefecture, and the group was able to see it in detail.

On the third day, the group visited Chiba City Miyazaki Elementary School, and exchanged views on the activities of school nurses working in the school infirmary, and then participated in a portion of classes. Eating school lunches allowed the group to experience the differences of school lunches between Japanese and American schools. Afterwards, the group visited the Nursing Department of the Makuhari Sogo High School and the Chiba Prefectural University of Health Sciences and exchanged views and visited the facilities.

On the fourth day, the group visited the Chiba University School of Nursing at exchanged views and toured the facilities. After lunch, they visited the Chiba City Folk Museum.
